Studio 30 Rules

- No smoking, alcohol or drug use anywhere on premises
- Limit of 8 people for photo or video shoots. An additional \$20 per person over the 8-person limit will apply. Total 15 people max in the Studio at one time.
- You must put away tables or chairs and clean any mess or debris left on the floor or counter top.
- We are happy to assist in putting away rented lighting equipment and stands. Backdrop may only be handled by Studio staff
- Water element shoots are restricted in the studio unless previously arranged with studio manager
- You are responsible for your own guests and their actions.
- You will be responsible for any damage to the space, furniture or decorations in the space and building.
- You will have access to the studio and washrooms. No access is allowed to the rest of the facility.
- No one will be admitted who is under the influence of alcohol or illegal substances
- No pets allowed without prior written consent from Studio management
- All small and/or hard to clean material (confetti, hair cutting, feathers, food products, body paint, etc.) require approval from company representative. Extra cleaning fee may apply

Arrival

Please arrive no sooner than 15 mins prior to your booking time. If you are running late, let us know as soon as possible if you'll require additional time.

Departure

Please allow at least 20-30mins (depending on production) for taking down equipment and packing up towards the end of your booking

Hanging From The Ceiling

- Nothing can be hung from the sprinkler pipes or the fluorescent lights. There are NO EXCEPTIONS!!
- Lighting can be hung from the steel beams only!
- All lights must be hung with beam clamps or other approved hardware.
- Every light that is hung MUST HAVE a safety cable as a secondary support system.
- If tie line or tape is used to secure the electrical cables it must all be removed when lighting is removed.
- Rolling stairs are available for hanging. BE AWARE that there is a Video Projector hanging from the ceiling.

Tape

- Tape may not be used on painted drywall surfaces
- Tape used on the floor must be low-tack tape. Damage to the floor paint will be deducted from the damage deposit.
